



About the Park

Three Island Park is located approximately 12 miles north of Bemidji off of US highway 71 and Co. Road 23. Bordered by Three Island Lake, the park covers 3,000 acres of land including diverse forests of hardwoods and conifers.

Ski Trail Grooming

Three Island County Park has gently rolling ski trails which are groomed for both skating and classical skiing. The park's mild terrain makes these trails perfect for beginners, yet the length of the system allows experienced skiers to complete a vigorous workout.

Parking & Restrooms

The Three Island trails can be accessed from two parking lot trailheads, and the trails themselves are well-marked so newcomers will easily find their way through the trail system. The south parking lot is located along the Woodhaven Resort road off County Road 22, and the north lot, adjacent to the Turtle River section, is located one mile down the Three Island County Park road off County Road 23. Toilets are located at each trail head for your convenience.

Summer and Fall Trail Usage

In the summer and fall, the trails are primarily used by mountain bikers, hikers and hunters. The park has several miles of snowmobile trails that interconnect with hundreds of miles of groomed trail in the county's snowmobile system. ATV's are only allowed on the snowmobile trails in the summer and must be kept on the trail at all times. **Wetland violations will be strongly enforced.**

Hunting

In the fall, the park is open for grouse and waterfowl hunting. Deer hunting is permitted during the designated state hunting season and all state laws apply in the recreation area. ATV's can be used on all trails for hunting only.

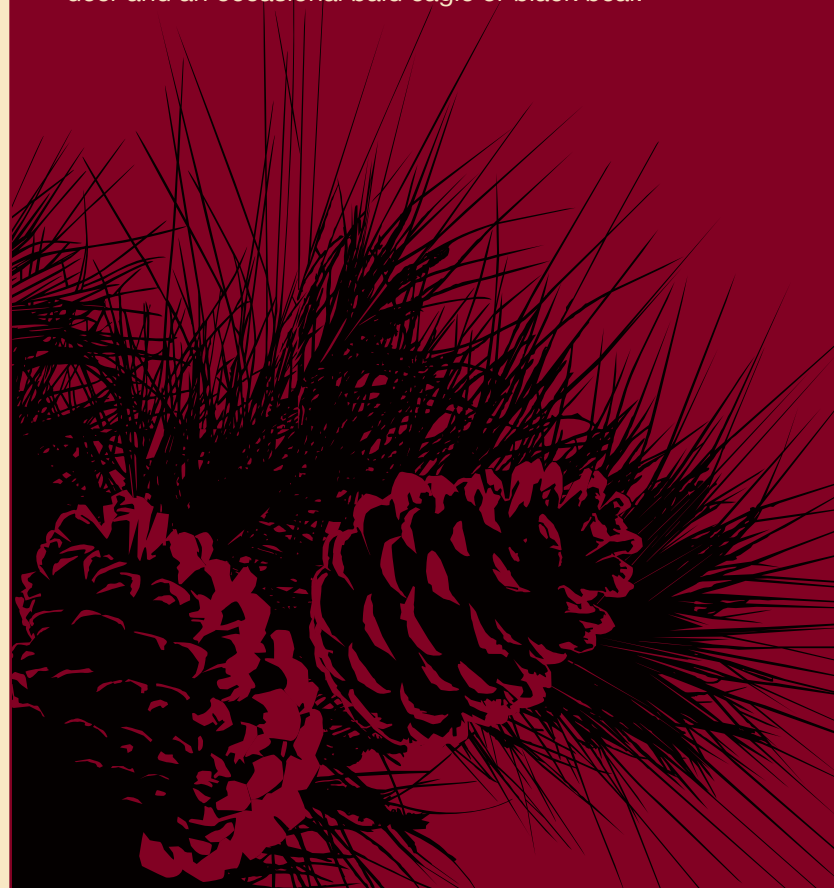
Three Island Park

Welcome

Three Island Park is known for its excellent ski trail system and day-use picnic area on the Turtle River. In the winter, the ski trails run adjacent to and across the Turtle River, allowing guests to enjoy the beautiful winter scenery.

A snowmobile trail also runs through the park, connecting to over 400 miles of groomed trails in the county.

At our convenient boat access on Three Island Lake, you will find many walleye and northern pike, and wildlife can be spotted around any corner, particularly whitetail deer and an occasional bald eagle or black bear.

Help Us Preserve the Park's Natural Beauty

When visiting the park it is important to follow these park rules:

- ▶ Take all garbage with you when leaving the park.
- ▶ Do not build or maintain a fire in the park except in a fire ring provided for that purpose.
- ▶ At the present time, overnight camping is not allowed in the park without a special permit which guests can apply for at the County Natural Resource Office.
- ▶ Vandalism of county property is unlawful and could lead to a misdemeanor charge and a heavy fine.
- ▶ Motorized vehicles and snowmobiles are allowed only on designated trails.
- ▶ Pets shall be attended to at all times and shall be restrained by a leash not exceeding six feet in length in the day use picnic area.
